FREDERICKSBURG, Va. — The Fredericksburg Center for the Creative Arts presents “Texture and Pattern” during September. One of the artists juried into the show is Deborah Herndon of Charleston, W.Va.

This national all-media, juried exhibit will be featured in the FCCA Frederick Gallery, 813 Sophia St. The show opens today.

Herndon’s “Gaudi Light, Barcelona,” a metallic photograph, was selected to be part of the exhibit. Three of her works are also part of the gallery’s juried Regional Exhibit.
